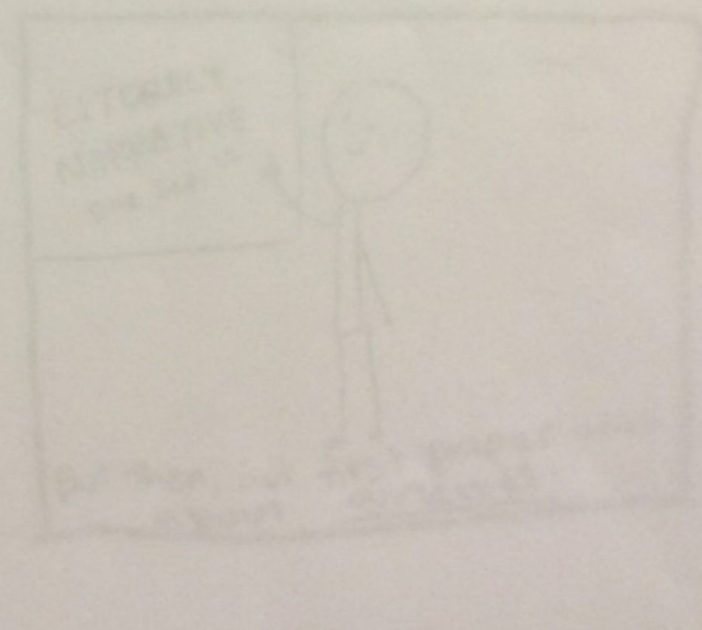
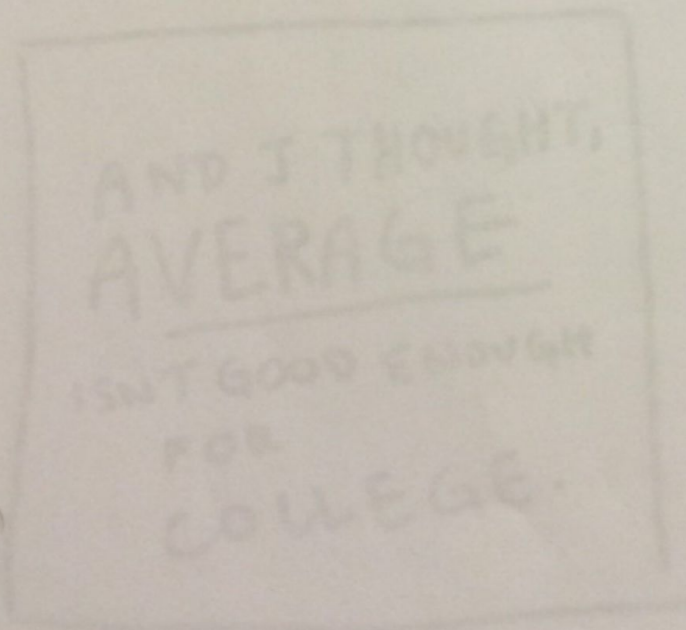


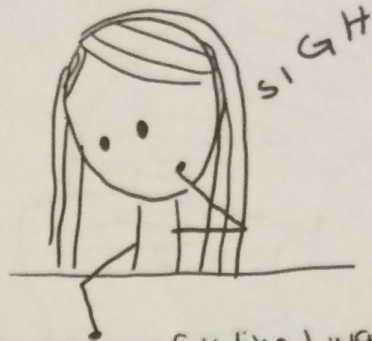

It always felt like I was just going on and on about something no one cared about.



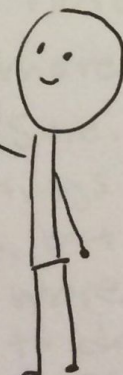
I was terrified of what college professors would say about my writing.



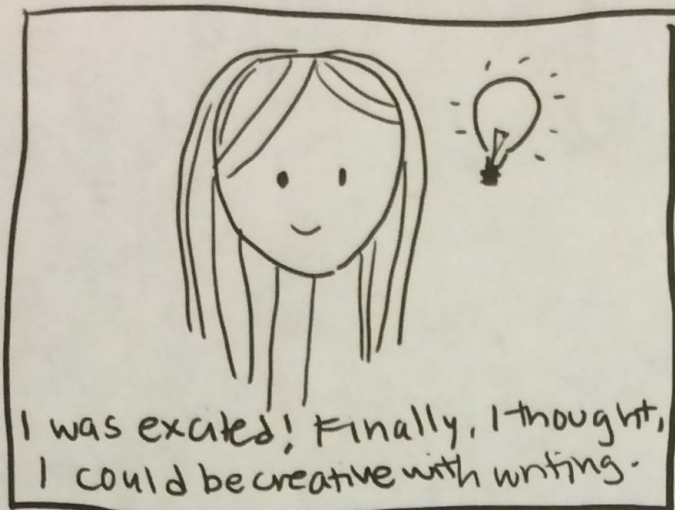
Everyone in high school had been smart. I was average.

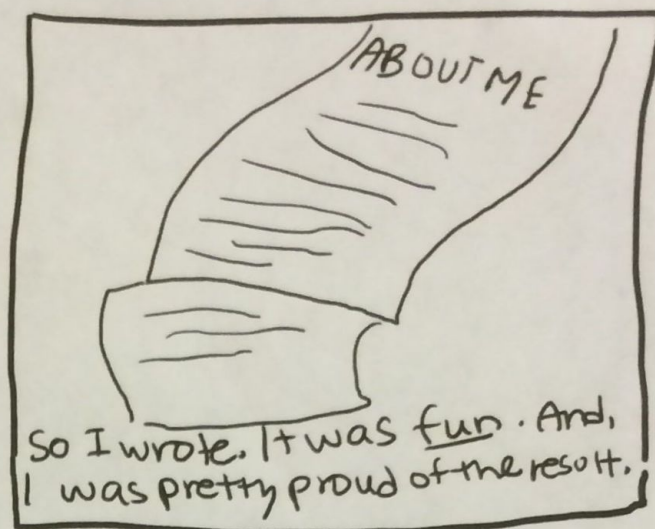

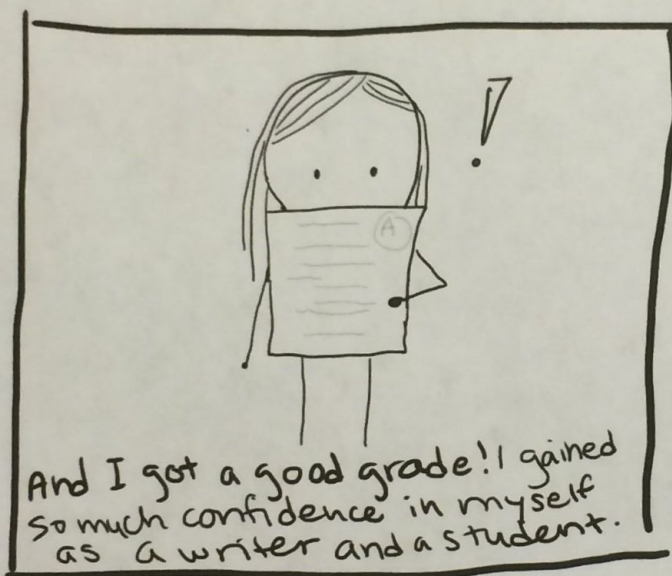
But then, our first paper was about ourselves.



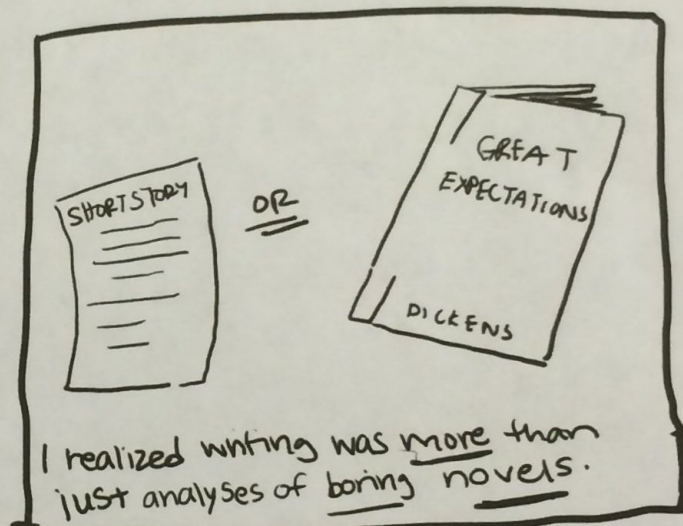
I was excited! Finally, I thought, I could be creative with writing.



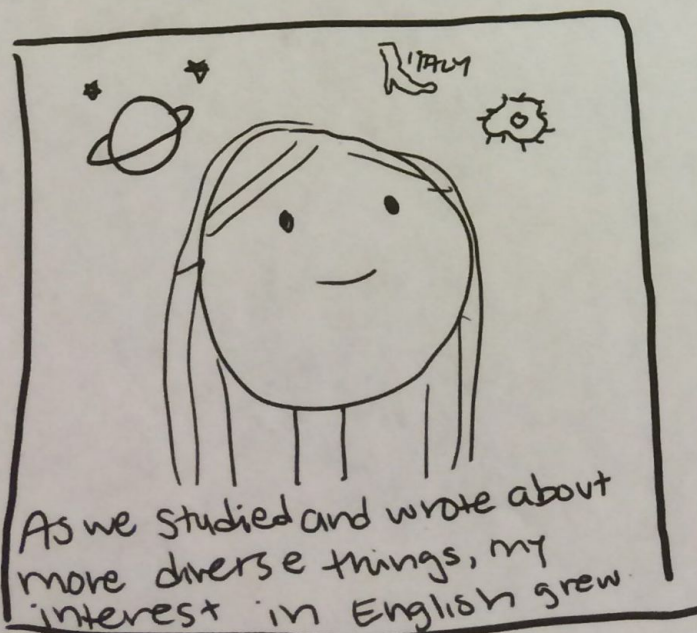
So I wrote. It was fun. And, I was pretty proud of the result.
